Fire Alarm Test – Friday 20 May 2011

1 The Parliament House Emergency Warning Intercommunications System will be undergoing a necessary test between 2:00pm and 3:00pm today. The test is required to ensure “regulatory compliance” for the new office area to the rear of the Staff Dining Room.

2 A short announcement will be made a few minutes before the test commences. The test will involve sounding of the ‘Alert’ and ‘Evacuation’ signals in some areas on the north side of the building. These areas include the public car park, the Marble Foyer, Great Hall, the Staff Dining Room, the Health and Recreation Centre, and the area around Aussies General Store.

3 Members of the public and building occupants will not be required to evacuate the building as part of this test.
