BROADCASTING STATIONS LICENCE FEES AMENDMENT BILL 1977

Short Digest of Bill

Purpose

This Bill amends section 6 of the Broadcasting Stations Licence Fees Act 1964 to provide for increases to certain licence fees for broadcasting stations.

Provisions

Section 6 of the Act is amended:

- a) by substituting numbers for words
- b) by inserting paragraphs in subsection (2) which extend the range of per centum annual payments for those broadcasting stations whose gross earnings exceed \$4,000,000. Such stations will pay:
 - 5% of such part of those gross earnings as exceeds \$4,000,000 but not \$4,500,000.
 - 5½% of such part of those gross earnings as exceeds \$4,500,000 but not \$5,000,000.
 - 6% of such part of those gross earnings as exceeds \$5,000,000.

The new rates will apply from 1 September 1977.
