Sport contributing to Closing the Gap

- Indigenous Sport Development Officers Program.
- Elite Indigenous Travel and Accommodation Assistance Program, and
- other participation funding grants to national sporting organisations

At the hearing the Committee will hear from the Director of Left-field Business Solutions, Mr Carl Currey who will discuss the significance of sport on educational, employment, health and wellbeing outcomes for Indigenous Australians.

Committee Chair, Mr Shayne Neumann MP said, "Sport can be a hook that engages Indigenous community members in physical activity and at the same time benefits other outcomes such as improved health, education and employment."

"The Committee is keen to find out how successful sports programs and initiatives have been in improving participation of Indigenous Australians and in Closing the Gap outcomes."

Mr Neumann added "This Committee hearing follows a significant day in the House of Representatives which saw bipartisan support for the passage of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Recognition Bill and a step towards constitutional recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people of Australia."
