

At the Executive Meeting of the Western Queensland Local Government Association incorporating sixteen Western Queensland Shire Councils the issue of voters being unable to cast their votes via absentee voting at polling booths within the Western Region was discussed.

It was resolved after extensive discussion regarding this problem that the Association contacts the Australian Electoral Commission highlighting the difficulties faced by the Returning Officers during the Federal Election with a view to introducing the option of "prepoll or absentee voting."

It appears ludicrous that voters wishing to cast their votes are turned away from the polling booths and directed to a centre several driving hours away to vote. Many prospective voters who are unable to reach the alternative booths leave their contact details with the Returning Officers for verification that they have attempted to vote and hence not attract a fine.

The Association wishes to lobby for the introduction of prepoll or absentee voting system to be made available in voting centres in the Western Queensland Local Government Association's region.

You consideration of the above proposed options is requested.
