Dear Mr Swoboda

I refer to the Hon. Bruce Scott MP's request at the public hearings of 27 June 2008, 6 August 2008 and 27 September 2008 for information regarding the number of postal votes that were rejected by reason of being postmarked after polling day.

At the hearing of 6 August 2008, the AEC State Manager for Queensland, Ms Anne Bright, indicated the AEC would be able to provide the information as requested. Whilst the AEC is unable to provide the information exactly as requested, it is able to provide the aggregated total of postal votes rejected for the following reasons relating to being cast or received late:

- the voter declaration was signed after polling day (cast late);
- the envelope was received 13 days after polling day (received late);

These data have been compiled by division and are set out in the enclosed Table 1. Postal votes rejected because the envelope was postmarked after polling day will, for the most part, be included in the total for postal votes rejected because the voter declaration was signed after polling day (i.e. votes cast late).

The AEC also wishes to provide clarification regarding the information it has previously provided to the JSCEM in response to Mr Scott's enquiries. The then Commissioner, Mr Ian Campbell, advised the JSCEM on 1 September 2008 that 4,729 postal votes were rejected because the voter declaration was signed after polling day or the envelopes were postmarked after polling day. In addition, Mr Campbell noted that 2,725 postal votes were rejected on the grounds that they were not received within the proscribed period (13 days) after polling day. These figures and their total (7,454) contrast with the totals provided in Table 1. The figures provided by Mr Campbell relate to rejected postal votes which resulted in an advice being sent to the voter from a central mailhouse.

As the JSCEM is no doubt aware, all declaration voters whose votes are rejected are sent an advice from the AEC. Prior to this a 'culling' process is undertaken to

remove those electors who have died since casting their vote and those who are silent electors. All advices sent to silent electors are sent from each divisional office.

For the 2007 election, 43 deceased electors and 544 silent electors were removed from the total of 8,041 rejected postal votes. The balance of 7,454 electors were sent letters from a mailhouse company; 4,729 letters advised electors their vote had been cast late and 2,725 letters advised electors their vote had been received late. It is these latter figures which were provided to JSCEM on 1 September 2008. The enclosed Table 2 provides a breakdown by division of the voter advices sent, and the reason and number of rejected postal voters excluded from this total.

I trust this information addresses the matters raised to date by Mr Scott relating to the rejection of postal votes.
