



### Public hearing into dental services

A range of government and non-government stakeholders will discuss the priorities for dental service delivery at the Health and Ageing Committee’s second public hearing for the inquiry into adult dental services on Monday, April 22.

The Committee will hear from state and territory governments as well as consumer groups and other health stakeholders. Participants will discuss options for the future of the National Partnership Agreement for adult public dental services.

Areas for discussion will include providing services to Indigenous Australians, rural and remote populations and people with special needs, workforce issues, and improving access to those in need.
