Inquiry into a new Regional Development Funding Program RE:

We write to contribute our view on the Regional Partnerships program and how this has contributed to a most successful international marketing program for our region, in partnership with the Mornington Peninsula and Phillip island regions.

Our submission in 2006 included funding support for these three regions within two hours of the Melbourne CBD to produce a range of collateral for distribution to key international wholesale trade partners. This included the production of a CD Rom for the Yarra Valley and the Dandenongs, expansion of the photographic library, production of flip charts and distribution of the material.

The highlight of this particular program was the production of Melbourne's South and East Touring Map. This map featured over 50 products from across the three regions and further funding support from the three regional tourism bodies allowed a 30,000 print run to be extended to 100,000. This project was delivered in 2006 and since then most of the tourism maps have been delivered to various travel partners nationally and internationally. The map has been so successful that an initiative is underway with further funding support to redevelop and reprint it.

The application process was rigorous and ensured that every facet of the project was well planned and provided strategic direction and clear key performance indicators. Melbourne based staff from the Department of Transport and Regional Services worked alongside our office assisting with the application and ensuring that the criteria were met before the application was formally lodged.

The Regional Partnerships Program has allowed many us to grow and develop that would not have been as easy without the support of the program.

We would be very disappointed to see any decrease or cuts to what has been a most beneficial program for the tourism and visitor services industry not just in our own region, but across this great nation.
