Austrade response to Standing Committee questions/recommendations below:

The submission from the Australia Africa Business Council Victoria Chapter (Sub. 55, p. 7) has made three recommendations calling for government support for the establishment of an Australia/Africa Trade Desk located in Victoria, but serving all of Australia (Transcript, 6 May, p. 6).

Has the AABC Vic Chapter sought support from the Commonwealth?

Austrade in partnership with DFAT have supported AABC activities, particularly in assisting with visiting African delegations and business forums.

What is your response to this proposal?

Approaches for support from the Commonwealth have been made by AABC at the national level.
