Inquiry into care of Australian Defence Force personnel wounded and injured on operations

Public Hearing on Friday 8 February

Tomorrow several leading South Australian figures in the care and repatriation of wounded and injured veterans will appear before the parliamentary inquiry into the care of Australian Defence Force personnel wounded and injured on operations.

The chair of the Defence Sub-Committee, Senator Mark Furner, said the Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade was very concerned about the treatment of wounded and injured ADF personnel while in operational areas. Equally as important, however are their repatriation arrangements and their care on return to Australia, including ongoing health, welfare, and rehabilitation support arrangements.

"With the transfer of 7th Battalion, Royal Australian Regiment to South Australia, and with their recent deployments to Afghanistan, it is important that there is a solid, systematic veterans' support base in Adelaide", Senator Furner said. "We are very interested in hearing about not only local success stories, but also recommendations for improvement in veterans' welfare".
