- (1) On the purchase of the first 100,000 vaccine doses (in which all have an interest), A, B and C each contribute one third of [sterling]100,000 (i.e. [sterling]33,333.33)
- (2) On the purchase of the second 100,000 vaccine doses (in which only B and C have an interest) B and C each contribute one half of [sterling]100,000 (i.e. [sterling]50,000)
- (3) On the purchase of the third and final 100,000 doses (in which only C has an interest) C will contribute [sterling]100,000.
