

National Capital Authority to appear before the NCET Committee

12.30pm - 1.45pm, Wednesday, 19 June 2013

The National Capital Committee will question the National Capital Authority (NCA) at its biannual public hearing on Wednesday, 19 June 2013 from 12.30 to 1.45 pm in **Committee Room 2S1**, Parliament House, Canberra.

This hearing will provide an opportunity for the Committee to ask the NCA about recent developments concerning pay parking in the Parliamentary Triangle, as well as the review of the National Capital Plan and the status of current and proposed works projects in the National Capital.

Committee Chair, Senator Louise Pratt, noted that the NCA appeared before the Committee at its public hearing last week regarding amenity in the Parliamentary Triangle, and that the related issues of pay parking and the provision of amenity continue to attract considerable interest in Canberra.

The hearings are a means of raising the level of transparency and parliamentary accountability applying to the NCA.

The NCA manages the Commonwealth's interest in the planning and development of Canberra and the Territory by administering the National Capital Plan and areas designated as National Lands.
