## DEFENCE RESPONSE TO PWC SUBMISSION FROM THE GREATER REGIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR WORK EMPLOYMENT COUNCIL (GROW)

- 1. Thank you for referring a copy of the letter dated 29 August 2003 from the office of the Greater Regional Opportunities for Work Employment Council (GROW) concerning the RAAF Base Richmond Reinvestment project.
- 2. Defence appreciates the strong support of GROW with respect to this proposal. GROW promotes growth and development throughout the Hawkesbury region and the submission highlights the importance of RAAF Base Richmond to the economic and social fabric of the wider Hawkesbury region.
- 3. Representatives from GROW, the Member for Macquarie, Mr Kerry Bartlett MP, the Member for Londonderry, Mr Alan Shearan MLA, the Mayor of City of Hawkesbury, Dr Rex Stubbs OA, representatives from NSW Government agencies and Hawkesbury City Council were briefed by Defence on the proposed RAAF Base Richmond Reinvestment project on 8 August 2003. At this briefing, Defence advised its intention, subject to Parliamentary approval, to initiate a limited reinvestment at the Base to ensure operational capability is maintained in the medium term.
- 4. Over the planned construction period of up to three years, an average of about 50 personnel will be directly employed on construction activities. In addition, it is anticipated that construction would generate further job opportunities off-site from the prefabrication of components and the manufacture and distribution of materials.

5. Defence acknowledges the need to consider the broader regional issues when delivering the works for the Base, and will endeavour to maximise the opportunities for local industry through its method of procuring the proposed works.
