- (b) Mitigating Circumstances:
  - (i) location including the immediate Cairns area has sustained minimum damage from the past 2 cyclones, Larry & Yasi, and has not been subject to flooding.
  - (ii) Over the past 10 years only minor claims have been made to our insurers.
- (c) It appears there are only 2 insurers available to FNQ Body Corporates. This lack of competition is detrimental to normal competition in the marketplace.
- (d) Legislation is needed to:
  - (i) Overcome the misleading presentation of insurance policies and ensure consumers are made fully aware and clearly understand their cover.
    - (ii) Ensure reasonable cost of insurance
  - (iii) Ensure that these funds are not being used to subsidize flood cover in the South East corner
- (f) Conclusion:

Clearly a government insurance body is needed to bring competition and fair business practices to the insurance industry.
