## Customs Tariff Proposal (No. 1) 2006

**Motion to be moved by Mr Hunt (Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for the Environment and Heritage) on 15 June 2006**

1. That the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*, as proposed to be altered by Customs Tariff Proposals, be further altered as set out in the Schedule to this Proposal and that the further alterations operate on and from 1 July 2006.
2. That the alteration proposed at item 1 of the Schedule to this Proposal applies to goods entered for home consumption on or after 1 July 2006.
3. That in this Proposal, “Customs Tariff Proposals” means –

Customs Tariff Proposal No. 4 (2005) introduced into the House of Representatives on 13 October 2005; and

Customs Tariff Proposal No. 5 (2005) introduced into the House of Representatives on 13 October 2005.

### Schedule—Alterations to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*

#### 1 Schedule 4 (item 31, the description of goods in column 2)

Omit “repair or maintenance of aircraft”, substitute “repair, maintenance or modification of aircraft”.

#### 2 Schedule 4 (item 71)

Repeal the item, substitute:

71	Goods, including machinery, equipment, or their components, as prescribed by by-law:	Free
	(A) that are entered for home consumption on or after 1 July 2002, and are for use in any of the following industries:	
	(i) mining;	
	(ii) resource processing;	
	(iii) agriculture;	
	(iv) food processing;	
	(v) food packaging;	
	(vi) manufacturing (within the meaning of the <i>Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC)</i> );	
	(vii) gas supply; or	



- (B) that are imported and entered for home consumption on or after 1 July 2006, and are for use in either of the following industries:
  - (i) power supply;
  - (ii) water supply
