## Customs Tariff Proposal (No. 2) 2007

**Motion moved by Mr Ruddock (Attorney-General) on 31 May 2007**

1. That the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*, as proposed to be altered by Customs Tariff Proposal, be further altered as set out in the Schedule to this Proposal and that the further alterations apply as set out in the Schedule.
2. That in this Proposal, “Customs Tariff Proposal” means:

### Schedule—Alterations to the Customs Tariff Act 1995

#### 1 Subparagraph 16(1)(l)(i)

After “Schedule 6”, insert “and the goods meet the description, if any, also specified in that column”.

#### 2 Schedule 6 (cell at table item 1086, column 2)

Repeal the cell, substitute:

7217.10.00

Goods other than low relaxation prestressed concrete steel  
wire, ribbed or indented

#### 3 Application

The amendments made by items 1 and 2 apply in relation to:

- (a) goods imported into Australia on or after 1 June 2007; and
- (b) goods imported into Australia before 1 June 2007, where the time for working out the rate of import duty on the goods had not occurred before 1 June 2007.
