## **Additional Comments by Coalition Senators**

- 1.1 Coalition Senators make the following additional comments on the interim report.
- 1.2 The Senate Select Committee on Red Tape's motivation in addressing the considerable regulatory burden of red tape has identified issues diminishing the safe and efficient supply of medicine.
- 1.3 These issues include the Pharmacy Rules affecting the access and supply of medicine, tax compliance burdens, issues surrounding the PBS remuneration processes, and outdated processes affecting the PBS Safety Net.
- 1.4 The committee also found issues with state ownership rules affecting community pharmacies in addition to issues arising as a consequence of highly varied medicine legislation between states.
- 1.5 Noting that this is an interim report, Coalition Senators will provide additional comments on these issues once the final report has been tabled.
