## Finance and Public Administration Legislation Committee

The committee called:

- the Public Governance, Performance and Accountability Bill
- unscheduled absences, and bullying and harassment in the Australian Public Service (APS)
- the number, proportion and level of Indigenous employees in the APS
- the departure of National Mental Health Commission Chief Executive Officer, Ms Robyn Kruk
- the convention which prevents the release of the content of assessments by the Office of National Assessments (ONA)
- links between the ONA and the Lowy Institute.
