Community Affairs Legislation Committee

The committee met on Wednesday, 26 February 2014 from 9.00 am to 11.01 pm.

The committee called the:

- community awareness grants to promote organ and tissue donation with a focus on events promoting awareness for families
- the reduced need for fresh blood and the changes in the clinical use of blood
- the Grow Up Smiling dental program
- trauma as an underlying mental health issue, including training provided to doctors in dealing with trauma
- the promotion of e-health records through Medicare Locals and state hospitals
- the Commonwealth Medical Internships initiative and proposals for new medical schools
- a review of the Life Saving Drugs Program
- Rural and Regional Health Australia programs
- antimicrobial resistance.
