Environment and Communications Legislation Committee

The committee met on Monday, 26 May 2014 from 9 am to 8.58 pm.

The committee called the department and agencies of the Environment portfolio, including the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM), the National Water Commission, the Commonwealth Environmental Water Office, the Murray-Darling Basin Authority (MDBA) and the Clean Energy Regulator.

- The educative role of the Clean Energy Regulator
- The Emissions Reduction Fund
- Renewable energy certificates.
