

Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee Supplementary Budget Estimates 2016-17 Monday, 17 October 2016 Daily summary

Here is the summary of today's proceedings in the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Estimates.

The committee met from 9.00am until 11.05pm.

The committee called:

- one agency from the Attorney-General's portfolio, the Australian Federal Police; and
- the Department of Immigration and Border Protection, the sole agency of the Immigration and Border Protection portfolio.

Areas of interest covered today by the committee include:

- Counter-terrorism activities and targeting the radicalisation of young people;
- Foreign fighters measures, war tourism and private citizens' travel to Iraq and Syria;
- An update on the work of Operation Sovereign Borders;
- The publication of the 'Nauru Files' and incident reporting at the Nauru Regional Processing Centre; and
- The welfare of Department of Immigration and Border Protection staff dealing with trauma, especially in frontline positions.
