

## Senate Environment and Communications Legislation Committee Supplementary Budget Estimates 2016-17 Tuesday, 18 October 2016 Daily summary

The committee met from 9.00 am until 11.00 pm.

The committee called calling the department and agencies of the Communications and Arts portfolio commencing with the department, the Australian Media and Communications Authority, Special Broadcasting Service, Australian Broadcasting Corporation, Australia Post, and NBN Co. The committee released the Australia Council and Screen Australia without questioning due to timing constraints and caring responsibilities. The committee has agreed to call NBN Co to appear at an additional hearing at a date yet to be determined.
