#### WRIT FOR THE ELECTION OF SENATORS

#### COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA

To DOUGLAS GRAHAM ORR, the Australian Electoral Officer for the State of New South Wales.

#### **GREETING:**

We command you to cause election to be made according to law of twelve Senators for our State of New South Wales to serve in the Senate of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia. And we appoint the twenty-third day of May 2016 as the day for the close of the Rolls.
