
NOTICE OF MOTION

I give notice that on the next day of sitting I shall move that -

That the Senate -

a) Notes that:

- Non-government organisations and media in Bangladesh have reported that Bangladeshi security forces have killed more than 100 people since May this year;
- ii) United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights, Zeid Ra'ad Al Hussein, has called for the extra-judicial killing of suspected drug offenders to be "immediately halted" and for the perpetrators brought to justice;
- iii) Human Rights Watch report that members of civil society groups face death threats, attacks from extremist groups and escalating harassment and surveillance by security forces; and

b) Calls on the Foreign Minister to:

- i) Encourage the Bangladeshi government to adopt and adhere to democratic and judicial processes and to hold free and fair elections under the auspices of a neutral authority;
- ii) Assist the Bangladeshi government to alleviate the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Bangladesh; and
- iii) Call for the immediate release of all political prisoners in Bangladesh.
