AMENDMENT AGREED TO BY THE SENATE ON  
THURSDAY, 6 DECEMBER 2018**

At the end of the motion, add, “and, in respect of:

- (a) the Sex Discrimination Amendment (Removing Discrimination Against Students) Bill 2018, the bill and all circulated amendments to the bill be referred to the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 11 February 2019;
- (b) the Treasury Laws Amendment (Consumer Data Right) Bill 2018, the bill be referred to the Economics Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 18 March 2019;
- (c) the Treasury Laws Amendment (Prohibiting Energy Market Misconduct) Bill 2018, the bill be referred to the Economics Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 18 March 2019;
- (d) National Integrity (Parliamentary Standards) Bill 2018, the provisions of the bill be referred immediately to the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 5 April 2019; and
- (e) National Integrity Commission Bill 2018 (No. 2), the bill be referred immediately to the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 5 April 2019.”.
