Senator O'Neill

Mr President

I give notice that, on the next day of sitting, I shall move that the Senate:

- (1) notes the national framework agreed to by the Council of Australian Governments (COAG) in 2008 to tackle Indigenous disadvantage and the six priority areas for change identified by COAG;
- (2) further notes that reports are presented by the Prime Minister to the Australian Parliament annually on progress in meeting these Closing the Gap targets;
- (3) is of the view that the presentation of these annual reports should be marked by a special parliamentary procedure in recognition of the significance of these initiatives to all Australians;
- (4) therefore proposes to the House of Representatives that it consider marking the presentation of the Prime Minister's annual report on Closing the Gap by:
 - (a) hosting a meeting of the House to which senators are invited in a similar manner as senators are invited to attend addresses by foreign Heads of State, and
 - (b) inviting senior Indigenous leaders to be present when the Prime Minister's annual report is presented;
- (5) resolves that, on its presentation to the Senate, the Prime Minister's annual report on Closing the Gap and accompanying ministerial statement be listed for consideration as a government business order of the day, and that the Government undertake to provide for at least 2 hours consideration of the statement during government business time not more than eight sitting days following the presentation of the report to the Senate; and
- (6) This order have continuing effect.
