## To move-That the Senate

- (a) draws to the attention of the Minister for Veterans' Affairs, the Honourable Dan Tehan, MP, the work of the CEO of the RSL NSW, Mr Glenn Kolomeitz, in exposing the financial misconduct and poor governance at the State Council Level of RSL NSW, and notes that he has been under attack by his own organisation;
- (b) calls on the RSL NSW State Council and its caretaker management team to allow cease all industrial action against. Mr Kolomeitz to allow him to get on with the job that he was asked to do fixing RSL NSW's financial and structural problems and developing funding and welfare projects so as to support veterans and their families that are doing it tough; and
