Pursuant to the Senate Order on Departmental and Agency contracts of 20 June 2001 (amended 14 May 2015), I wish to advise that all entities within the Industry, Innovation and Science portfolio have placed a list of contracts to the value of \$100,000 (GST inclusive) or more, which have not been fully performed or which have been entered into in the 12 months prior to the 31 August 2017, on their websites.

Procurement contracts, which are a subset of all contracts, conducted by non-corporate Commonwealth entities' (NCEs) are not included in this contract listing. All NCE procurement contracts can be found through the Senate Order button on AusTender at www.tenders.gov.au. The report is titled 'Senate Order on Confidentiality in Procurement Contracts by Agency'.

The Industry, Innovation and Science portfolio listing is not complete for the reasons outlined below.

CSIRO's listing does not fully comply with the requirements of paragraph (2) of the Order because:

- 14 contracts, all of which are confidential, were not included on the basis that disclosure may reveal trade secrets which are judged to have the potential to cause detriment to the contractor. I am satisfied that the reason for not disclosing these contracts is appropriate.

- The amount of contract consideration has not been included for 94 contracts on the basis that the information is commercially sensitive to third parties and harm is likely to be caused by its disclosure. The names of contractors for 577 contracts has not been included for the same reason.
- The listing may contain errors or omissions due to technical issues with CSIRO's internal systems and processes, which currently do not have the functionality required to readily comply with these specific reporting requirements and format.

CSIRO has also excluded five contracts on the basis that disclosure would be contrary to the *Privacy Act 1988*.

AIMS' listing does not fully comply with the requirements of paragraph (2) of the Order as 24 contracts, all of which are confidential, were not included on the basis that disclosure may reveal trade secrets which are judged to have the potential to cause detriment to the contractor. I am satisfied that the reason for not disclosing these contracts is appropriate.

ANSTO's listing does not fully comply with the requirements of paragraph (2) of the Order because:

- The amount of contract consideration has not been included for 47 contracts on the basis that the information is commercially sensitive to third parties and harm is likely to be caused by its disclosure.
- The listing may contain errors or omissions due to technical issues with ANSTO's internal systems and processes, which currently do not have the functionality required to readily comply with these specific reporting requirements and format.

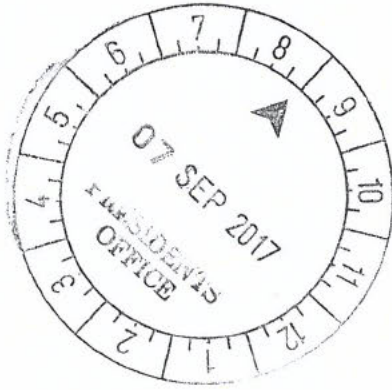
The department will actively work with CSIRO, AIMS and ANSTO to ensure that compliance with the requirements of the Order will improve in subsequent reporting periods.
