

Senate Environment and Communications Legislation Committee Budget Estimates 2017-18 Tuesday, 23 May 2017 Daily summary

Here is the summary of today's proceedings in the Senate Environment and Communications Budget Estimates.

The committee met from 9.00am until 8.39pm.

The committee called:

• the department and agencies of the Environment and Energy portfolio, including the Department of the Environment and Energy, Australian Renewable Energy Agency, Snowy Hydro Ltd, Clean Energy Finance Corporation, Clean Energy Regulator and the Office of the Supervising Scientist.

Some of the topics discussed by the committee included:

- review of the Australian Antarctic Science Strategic Plan;
- ANAO report on the replacement icebreaker vessel;
- funding for the DeGrussa solar project;
- feasibility study on the Snowy Hydro expansion;
- Clean Energy Innovation Fund funding for start-up projects;
- a second power interconnector across the Bass Strait;
- threat abatement plan for the impacts of marine debris on vertebrate marine life;
- the Carbon Farming Initiative ;
- funding for the National Climate Change Adaptation Research Facility ;
- tailings deposition strategy for the Ranger Mine;
- water related impacts of unconventional gas development; and
- security and reliability of the electricity market.
