Question:

- a) Senator SIEWERT: Can you provide me with a list of all the organisations in all of those five regions that you have contacted to let them know about what is going on?

Mr Tidswell: Yes, we will take that on notice.

- b) Senator SIEWERT: In terms of the meetings, could you detail all the communities where you have had them and all the people who were invited to those meetings in those five locations since the beginning of this process.

Ms Ramsey: We can take that on notice.

- c) Senator SIEWERT: In terms of how much you have spent on administration of the process to date, can you give me an overall amount? Then, on notice, could you break it down to each of the regions?

Mr Tidswell: In terms of the place based income management? Is that what you are after?

Senator SIEWERT: I do not mean to be pedantic again, but unless I say otherwise I am referring to the five place based—

Mr Tidswell: Our allocation for 2011-12 for the place based income management is \$9.1 million.

Senator SIEWERT: Is that for the administration process?

Mr Tidswell: Yes, to set up income management in those five locations and do the work we need to do to begin the whole process.

- d) Senator SIEWERT: Can I go back to a specific question around Playford and whether the local co-op has—

Ms Cartwright: We would need to take that one on notice.

Answer:

- a) Attachment A provides a list of all the organisations in all of the five regions that the department has contacted in relation to Place Based Income Management between November 2011 and February 2012 to keep them informed.
- b) The details of the community organisations that the department has contacted are listed in Attachment A. The department does not have a list of all the people who attended each of the meetings listed in Attachment A.
- c) The breakdown of how much the department has spent on process related administration to date by region is outlined in the table below:

- d) The department has engaged with two local Playford Community Food Co-ops at Smithfield and Elizabeth Downs in relation to receiving income managed funds. Currently, both Food Co-ops do not have EFTPOS facilities; this precludes them from being a BasicsCard Merchant. However, they are considering installing EFTPOS terminals and should this occur they have indicated that they would apply to be a BasicsCard Merchant.

The department has discussed other Income Management contract arrangements with the two Food Co-ops. These negotiations are in the early stages.
