Forty nine (49) graduates accepted FaHCSIA's offer of employment for the 2012 Program.

Graduates have been placed in the following Groups:

- Information Management and Technology - 2
- Business and Financial Services - 3
- Families - 8
- Women's and Children's Policy - 9
- Disability Long Term Care and Support - 2
- Housing Homelessness and Money Management - 7
- Indigenous Policy and Engagement - 4
- Indigenous Community and Economic Development – 1
- Office of Remote Indigenous Housing – 4
- Problem Gambling - 1

Graduate positions are APS3 positions, used each year to recruit the annual graduate intake.
