1. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio from the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?

a. Detail the items provided to the minister's office How much was spent on departmental stationary requirements from the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date.

Answer:

- 1. For the period 20 November 2013 to 28 February 2014 the cost of stationery requirements was \$6,551.
 - a. General office stationery items are provided to the minister's office eg pens, pencils, folders, notepads.

The cost for stationery for the Department of Health including National Industrial Chemicals Notification and Assessment Scheme, Office of Gene Technology Regulator and Therapeutic Goods Administration for the period 20 November 2013 to 28 February 2014 was \$145,678.
