Answer:

a) The Department of Health is coordinating the Australian Government response to the Senate Community Affairs References Committee report into Palliative Care in Australia.

All recommendations are being carefully considered and extensive consultation across government departments is occurring.

Timing for a response is a decision for the Government.

b) The National Palliative Care Program was consolidated within the Chronic Disease Prevention and Service Improvement Fund in 2011.

Funding for national palliative care projects is a decision for the Government.
