## Question:

a) What is the amount allocated to mental health research?
b) What percentage of the NHMRC research budget is allocated to mental health?

## Answer:

a) The National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) does not specifically allocate research funds to health areas. However as a result of the peer review, funds committed in 2013 to research that is relevant to mental health totalled $\$ 81,095,739$.
b) This was 10.1 per cent of the total funds $(\$ 800,508,614)$ the Australian Government, through NHMRC, committed to health and medical research in 2013.
