#### **Question:**

a) Please provide the amount of funding that was dedicated to palliative care programs from the Chronic Disease and Service Improvement Fund.

b) What Palliative Care projects have been funded? Please provide a list of these projects.

#### Answer:

- a) Since the Chronic Disease Prevention and Service Improvement Fund (CDPSIF) was established on 1 July 2011, funding totalling \$41.8M has been committed to national palliative care projects.
- b) Since 1 July 2011, 13 palliative care projects have been funded from the CDPSIF. These include:
  - Australian Palliative Care Knowledge Network CareSearch;
  - Data Development and Reporting;
  - National Standards Assessment Program;
  - Palliative Care Australia (core funding);
  - Palliative Care Clinical Studies Collaborative;
  - Palliative Care Curriculum for Undergraduates;
  - Palliative Care Outcomes Collaboration;
  - Program of Experience in the Palliative Approach;
  - Respecting Patient Choices;
  - Guidelines for a Palliative Approach for Aged Care in the Community Setting;
  - Guidelines for a Palliative Approach in Residential Aged Care;
  - Evaluation of the National Palliative Care Program; and
  - Chronic Disease Palliative Care Pathway Project.
