Question:

a) Can the Department confirm that the funding for this program has been reduced by \$40 million over the forward estimates?

- b) How many placements will be supported by this program in 2014?
- c) At how many locations?
- d) Where are those locations?

Answer:

- a) The Voluntary Dental Graduate Year Programme (VDGYP) commenced with 50 graduate placements in 2013. The 2012-13 Budget included funding to expand the VDGYP to 75 places in 2015 and 100 places in 2016. The Mid-Year Economic and Fiscal Outlook released on 17 December 2013 reversed the decision to expand the VDGYP from 2015, saving \$40.7 million over four years.
- b) 50 placements will be supported in 2014.
- c) 44 locations (this includes some placements that will operate across multiple locations).
