Senator Rachel Siewert asked:

In relation to the answer provided to question on notice 427 from Supplementary Budget Estimates 2016-17, were the figures provided for all trial sites?

(a) If not, which trial sites?

(b) What happened to the other 39 clients?

(c) What is the process for determining and recording for all the people in PHaMs – post-NDIS transition for all areas – the numbers who won't be eligible for the NDIS?

Answer:

- (a) The response to question on notice 427 from Supplementary Budget Estimates 2016-17 represents all trial sites to 30 June 2016.
- (b) Personal Helpers and Mentors providers reported 39 clients were deemed ineligible for the National Disability Insurance Scheme. These clients are eligible for continuity of support through their current provider.
- (c) From 1 July 2016, the National Disability Insurance Agency will collect information about the eligibility of clients transitioning from Commonwealth funded programs.
