**Answer:**

The central locations used for interviews for the Cashless Debit Card Evaluation were:

- Ceduna
  - Town Centre/Town Hall
  - Foreshore
  - Thevenard (IGA and Community Centre)
  - Yalata
  - Oak Valley
  
- East Kimberley
  - Kununurra
    - Coles Supermarket (shopping centre)
    - Messmate Way on the nature strip
    - Whitegum Park
    - Coolibah Drive – roaming Courthouse to Whitegum Park
    - Coolibah Drive – near High School, Primary School and training facilities
    - Waringarri Aboriginal Arts
    - Mirima Dawang Language Nest
    - Glen Hill
    - Emu Springs
  
  - Wyndham
    - Near Post Office
    - Outside local supermarket

In addition to the central locations, roving teams moved around the central regions of the towns to further extend the reach of the sampling.
