- 2. How many media or public relations advisers are employed in the Department? At what APS level (eg EL2, APS5) is each staff member employed? Can an organisational chart for the relevant area of the Department please be provided? What was the total cost of employing relevant staff in calendar year 2016 (please provide a global figure)?

Answer:

1. For the period 1 October to 31 December 2016, the Department spent \$111,158.26 (GST incl) on media monitoring.

2. On 31 December 2016, the Communication Services Branch (CSB) had 30.86 ongoing FTE and 7.00 non-ongoing FTE, making the total FTE 37.86. Of these, 1.00 non-ongoing FTE was a graphic designer.
