**Senator Linda Reynolds** asked:

Can the Committee be provided with a breakdown of the phasing of when young people in aged care will get into the NDIS (by month or quarter) for each NDIS roll out region for the rest of the NDIS roll out?

**Answer:**

In recognition that young people in residential aged care are a priority cohort, they are generally scheduled to transition early in each quarter or when a specific region is scheduled to commence transition.

A total of 2,058 young people in residential aged care are scheduled to commence transition into the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) by 30 June 2017. It is currently estimated that the transition of young people in residential aged care will be completed by mid-2020, with around 72 per cent (4,488 people) of this group to have commenced transition by mid-2018.

The timeframes for the commencement of the transition of young people in residential aged care into the NDIS by state and region is provided at **Attachment A**.
