## **Senator Siewert** asked:

Has construction of the Family and Wellbeing Centre in Amata been completed? If not, what is the timeline for this work? How much did it cost to establish this centre (i.e. the cost of modifying the existing facility)?

## **Answer:**

The refurbishment Amata Family Wellbeing Centre is scheduled for completion in mid-2012. The South Australian Government has advised that the concept design has been finalised and signed off by the relevant lead Department. Services are currently operating from the site.

\$4.95 million has been provided to the South Australian Government to support the construction of Family Wellbeing Centres in Amata, Mimili and Pukatja.
