Senator Siewert asked:

Has construction of the Family and Wellbeing Centre in Pukatja been completed? If not, what is the timeline for this work? What is the expected capital cost of this centre?

Answer:

The Pukatja Family Wellbeing Centre is scheduled for completion in mid to late 2012. The South Australian Government has advised that the concept design and site location have been finalised and signed off by the relevant lead department.

\$4.95 million has been provided to the South Australian Government to support the construction of Family Wellbeing Centres in Amata, Mimili and Pukatja.
