**Question:**

Following evidence about the development of the National Preventive Health Research Strategy, tell me a little about how you chose the organisations to consult with. Did you put it out there? Did they come to you? Tell me a little more about it and give me the ambit of stakeholders that you consulted with.

**Answer:**

A representative group of key organisations and individuals was identified to participate in the first consultation for the development of the National Preventive Health Research Strategy. The report of the consultation interviews which were conducted from December 2011 to January 2012 includes a list of those interviewed. The report is available on the Australian National Prevention Health Agency's (the Agency) website.

The Agency commenced a second round of consultation on a draft strategy on 12 July 2012. This is an open consultation for public comment which will be promoted through ANPHA's website and direct invitation to a wide range of individuals and organisations.
