Question:

Can you please provide an update as to the rollout of ATAPS? For example:

a) What is the geographical spread of these services?

b) On average, how many sessions are provided to patients on an annual basis?

c) Is ATAPS operating effectively and is it meeting the needs of specific groups such as people experiencing socio-economic disadvantage and/or people living in rural areas who are experiencing mild to medium forms of mental illness?

Answer:

- a) ATAPS services are provided in Medicare Local catchment areas in every State and Territory across Australia.
- b) In 2010-11, clients received on average 5 sessions.
- c) ATAPS is targeted at the most disadvantaged people living in the Australian communities including, children and their families, Indigenous Australians and people living in low socioeconomic areas. Since 2003, 57% of people accessing services under ATAPS have been low income earners and 41% of sessions have been delivered in rural locations.
