Question:

Was the funding that flows to community based health organisations held up as part of signing the agreement with the Northern Territory Government?

Answer:

No. The Department of Health and Ageing negotiated agreements directly with Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations (ACCHOs) under the Stronger Futures in the Northern Territory. The Implementation Plan agreed to with the Northern Territory (NT) Government relates to services being provided by the NT Government directly to Aboriginal people in the NT. The table at Attachment A provides a breakdown of which ACCHOs received funding and for what purpose. The table also identifies when the funding agreements/ variations with these organisations were executed.
