### Senator Waters, Larissa asked:

Can you please provide on notice a full breakdown of all the spending allocated so far out of the \$100 million over 4 years broken down by program and by financial year?

#### Answer:

The Second Action Plan of the *National Plan to Reduce Violence against Women and their Children 2010 - 2022* covers the calendar period 2013-2016. The relevant funding in the National Initiatives activity under *Programme 2.1 Family and Communities* covers the financial years: 2012 – 13 \$22.706, 2013 – 14 \$27.101, 2014 – 15 \$24.996, 2015 – 16 \$25.373, and 2016-17 \$25.888.

A range of key national infrastructure projects have been allocated and / or funded over the period 2013 – 2016 significantly greater than \$100 million: 1800RESPECT including the DAISY App, ANROWS including perpetrator research, Our Watch including *The Line*, DV-alert for training health and allied health workers, Australian Bureau of Statistics for the Personal Safety Survey and data projects, VicHealth for the National Community Attitudes Survey and White Ribbon Australia.

Furthermore, the amounts setout above do not include the significant additional funding for the recently announced increase in funding for 1800RESPECT and the national campaign to reduce violence against women and their children.
