Senator Moore, Claire asked:
Please provide the average income-their income and impacts, depending on whether it is partial.

## Answer:

The estimated 45,000 women who are expected to receive a partial Paid Parental Leave (PPL) payment have median income of around $\$ 43,000$. This is exclusive of any the partner's income. The average employer-provided entitlement of this group and consequently their average loss in PPL is around $\$ 4,300$.
