## **Senator Collins, Jacinta** asked:

For the 45,000 women with an average income of \$43,000 a year will be negatively impacted by this measure are you able to break that down any further?

#### **Answer:**

The estimated 45,000 women expected to receive a partial Paid Parental Leave (PPL) payment will receive around \$4,300 less on average than under current arrangements. The estimated 2014-15 individual income distribution of these women is detailed below.
