## Answer:

a) The definition of a 'report' used in providing an answer to this Question on Notice is any report authorised by government, finalised, handed to government and subsequently made public. Reports produced as a component of work for Cabinet committees, inter-departmental committees, Coalition of Australian Government (COAG) working groups and internal committees are excluded.

Since Budget Estimates 2010, two reports have been commissioned by the Government in the Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs Portfolio.

As stated in the answer to Question on Notice 243-246 from Senator Fierravanti-Wells (2009–10 Additional Estimates February 2010), the Department does not separately identify the costs and number of staff supporting reports in the finance system. Consequently, the Department is unable to provide a response to this question.
