Do you have a state based breakdown on that sort of apprenticeship?

Answer:

COAG agreed that when contracting for government stimulus and infrastructure projects, the jurisdictions will aim to secure at least 10 per cent of the total contract labour hours to be undertaken by apprentices and trainees and those seeking to up-skill.

It is a requirement under the Social Housing Initiative Guidelines that jurisdictions report the actual number of apprentice and trainee jobs supported. Actual apprentice and trainee jobs data is provided on the completion of each project.
