Topic: National disability parking permits scheme

Senator Fifield asked:

Does the new national system now exclude Queenslanders with less severe, yet permanent, disabilities (i.e. red permit holders) because of the previous eligibility requirements in place in Queensland.

Answer:

The Queensland Government has decided that the Queensland red permit holders will not initially be issued with the new Australian Disability Parking permit. Current red permit holders will need to either apply for the new Australian Disability Parking permit or retain their existing red permit.
